When it comes to events destinations, there are locations and there are LOCATIONS. The Heritage Quarter hub of Dunfermline Carnegie Library & Galleries is the latter.

A versatile, unique, and unforgettable venue set in the shadow of Dunfermline Abbey; your guests will be in awe even before they set foot inside your event. When you finally

usher them over the threshold, they'll bring their awe with them as they're greeted by the world's first Carnegie Library and stunning views over the landscaped garden to the Abbey. And all of that is before they've even set foot in one of the Dunfermline Carnegie Library & Galleries' four unique rooms.

From The Canmore's bright and airy space and awesome acoustics to the Queen Margaret room, formerly the reference library, and its melding of historic charm with modern equipment, whether you're

hosting a board meeting or a banquet, there's a room that's the perfect venue.

The Bruce, a modern room ideal for smaller meetings and training, and the Queen Anne - a contemporary, creative space with its own breakout area - complete the Carnegie's offerings.

- A 10-minute walk from Dunfermline City train station with fast links from Edinburgh and Glasgow
- Just 25 minutes from Edinburgh Airport

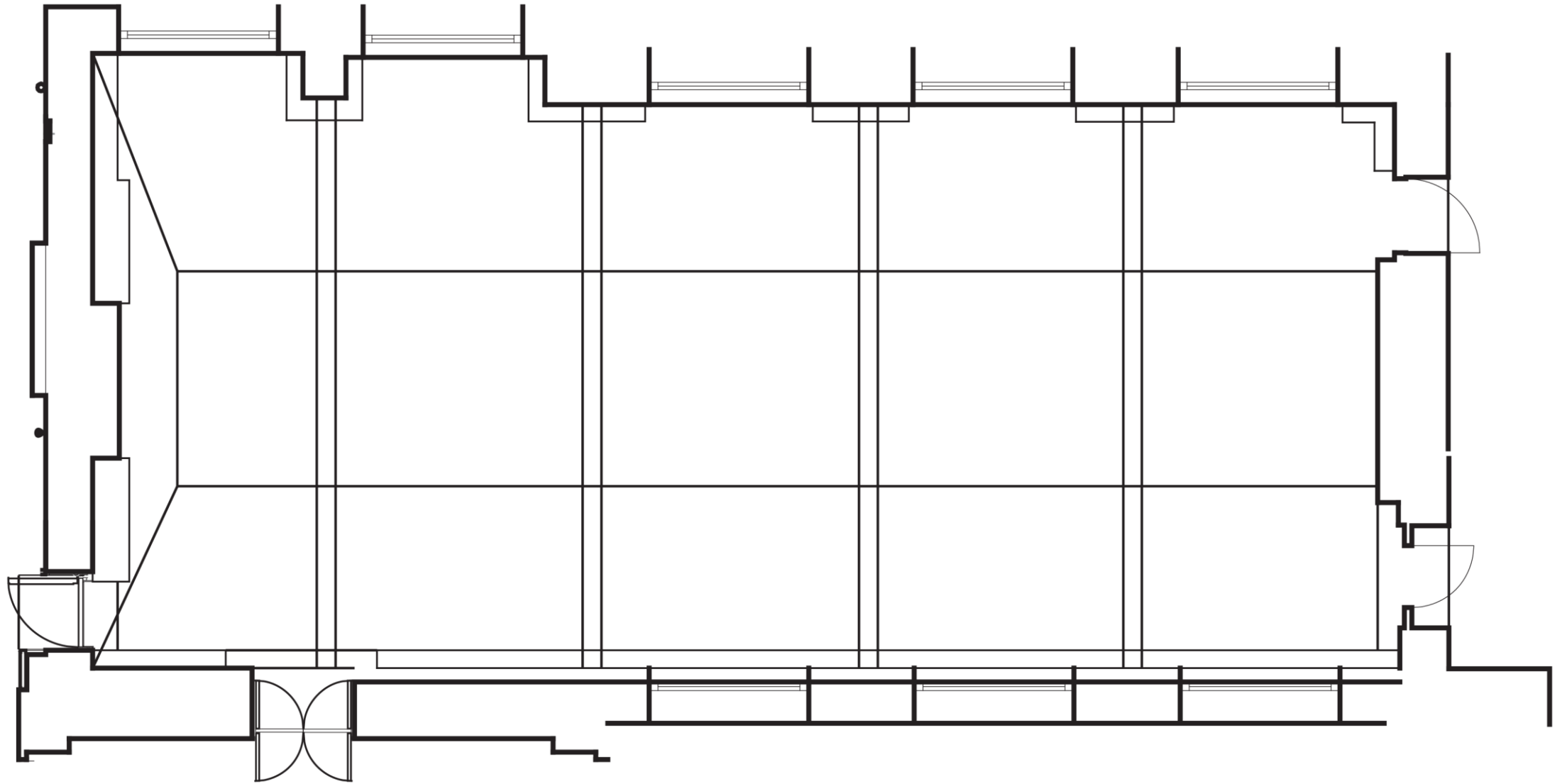
CANMORE ROOM

The Canmore Room is a flexible events space flooded with natural light, a bookcase lined wall, ornamental fireplace and a high vaulted ceiling. Boasts excellent acoustics creating the perfect backdrop for your event. Formally used as the reference library, this atmospheric room showcases a large painting commissioned by Andrew Carnegie and painted by Charles Martin Hardie which shows ownership of Pittencrieff Park being transferred to the town on 21st November 1903.

- Capacity: Theatre 130, Dinner 100, Cabaret 80, Reception 120
- Perfect for: Conferences, Meetings, Dinners, Lunches, Drinks Receptions, Weddings
- Features: Natural day light, screen & projector, power available 13amp sockets, Wi-Fi

QUEEN MARGARET ROOM

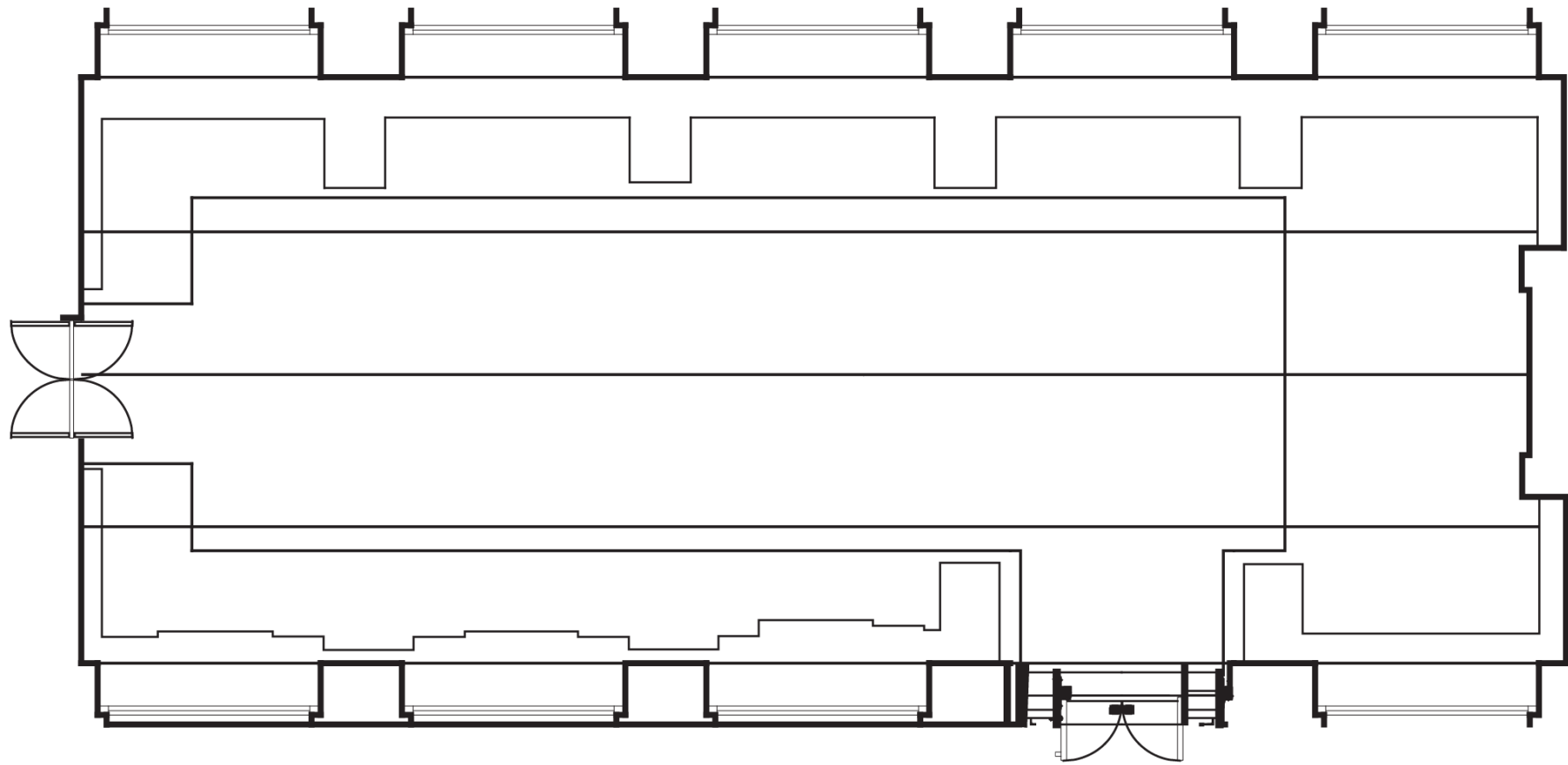
Formally the reference library which used to house the Muirson Burns Collection, the room retains its natural charm and character, complete with a statue of Robert Burns and his dog. It is decorated with a collection of panelled images showcasing some of the ornate spines from rare books, old maps and sepia images of Dunfermline which are retained in our collection. To complete the traditional feel of this room is an impressive carved oak buffet (c. 1860-1890). This impressive piece of craftsmanship is believed to have been part of the collection of Joseph Neil Paton, father of Sir Noel Paton, Dunfermline born artist and favourite artist of Queen Victoria. The ornate panels

decorating the buffet represent three national heroes, Robert the Bruce, William Wallace and St Margaret, Queen of King Malcolm Canmore. The eagle eyed will spot Robert the Bruce's spider has been included in its meticulous design.

- Capacity: Theatre 50, Dinner 40, Cabaret 32, Reception 20
- Perfect for: Boardroom style meetings & intimate dinners
- Features: Natural daylight, black out facilities, screen and projector, power available 13amp sockets & Wi-Fi. The Canmore Room can be entered via the connecting door

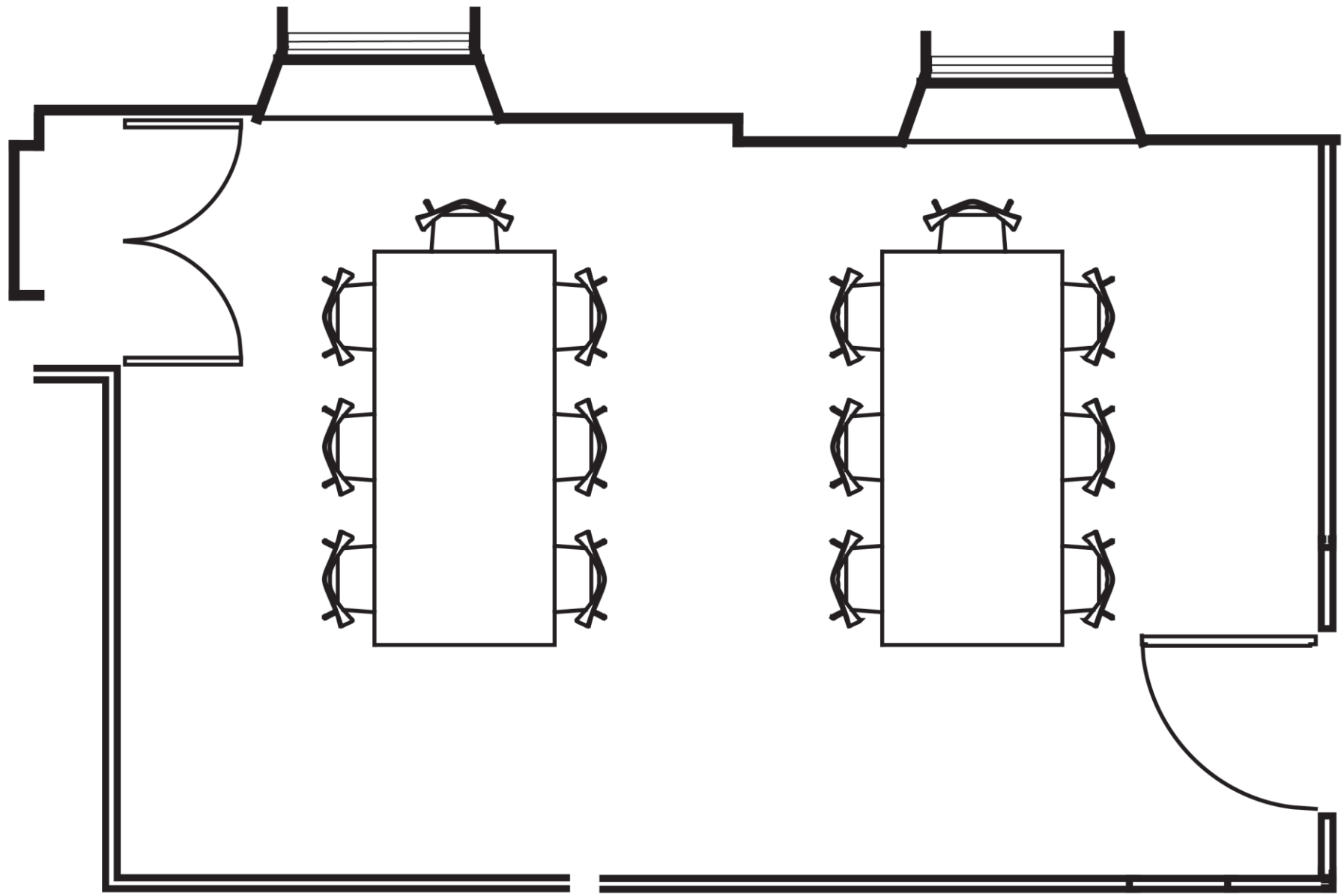
BRUCE ROOM

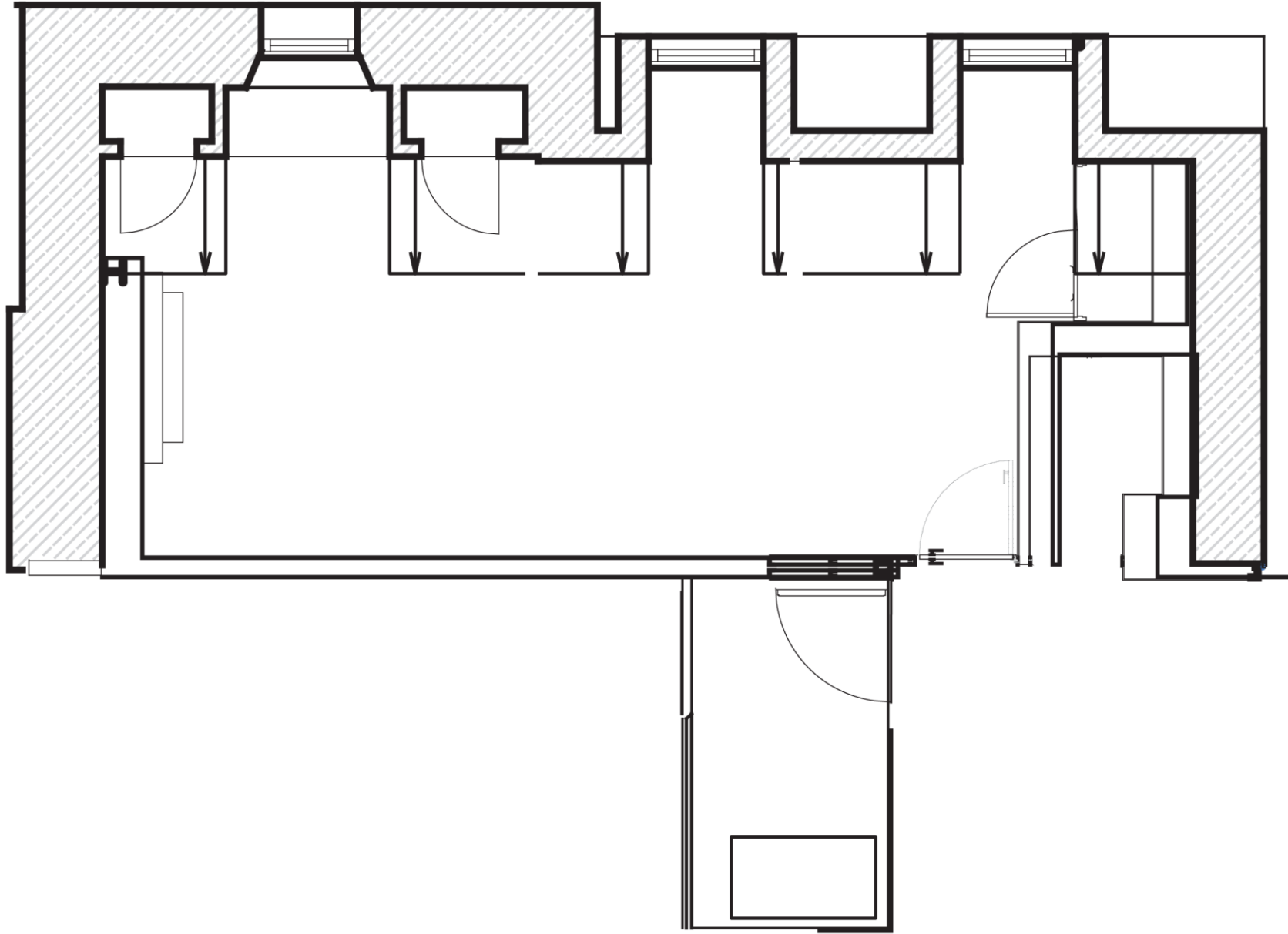
QUEEN ANNE ROOM

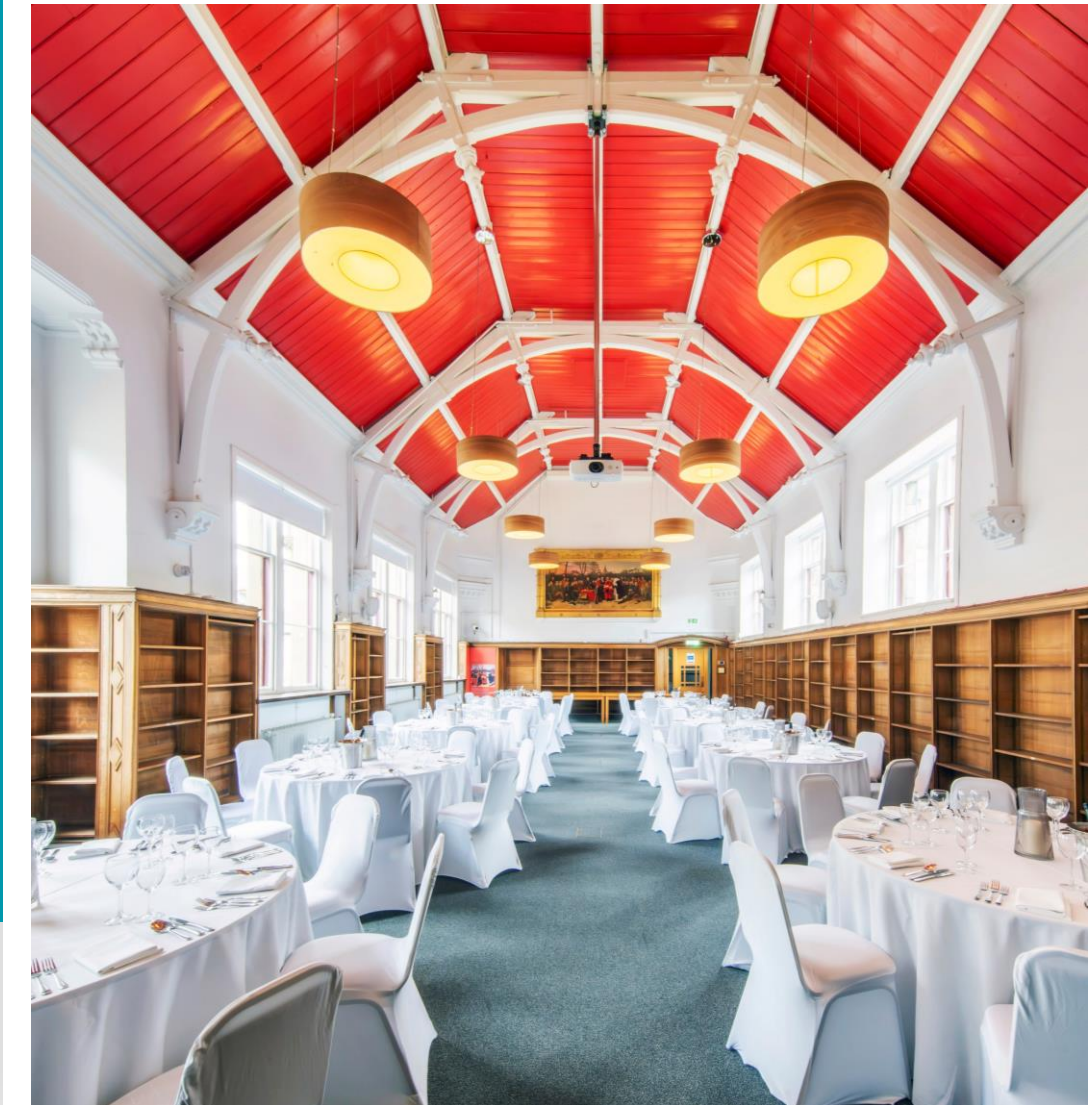
Contemporary creative space with its own breakout lounge. The space is bright and airy and is ideal for relaxed meetings and gatherings.
